### How to write?

In order to use Winbatch it, you must open up an editor (Notepad, Wordpad, MS-Word, etc.) and create a script using its syntax. Once written, the script is saved and run with an extension already associated with the Winbatch interpreter. In our examples, we use the extension .WBT.
